14	(c)	Has been or remains in substantially continuous
15		operation for a period in excess of thirty days or has
16		a gross revenue in excess of \$2,000 in any single day.

(3) Any property, including real property, gambling		
devices, paraphernalia used on fighting animals, or birds,		
implements, furniture, personal property, vehicles, vessels,		
aircraft, or gambling record possessed or used in violation of		
this section, or any money or personal property used as a bet o		
stake in gambling activity in violation of this section, may be		
ordered forfeited to the State, subject to the requirements of		
chapter 712A.		
(4) Operation of an illegal gambling business is a class C		
felony."		
SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
begun before its effective date.		
SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on March 22, 2075.
