A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON BEACHES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated								
3	and to read as follows:								
4	" <u>§200-</u> Prohibited commercial activities on certain								
5	beaches; administrative fine. (a) No commercial vendor shall								
6	preset commercial beach equipment on any beach under the								
7	jurisdiction of the department unless the customer is physically								
8	present for the immediate use of the commercial beach equipment.								
9	The commercial vendor shall expeditiously remove the commercial								
10	beach equipment after the customer has finished using it.								
11	(b) The department may authorize exemptions to subsection								
12	(a) through rules adopted pursuant to chapter 91.								
13	(c) Any commercial vendor who violates subsection (a)								
14	shall be subject to an administrative fine of:								
15	(1) \$5,000 for a first offense;								
16	(2) \$10,000 for a second offense; and								
17	(3) \$15,000 for a third or subsequent offense.								

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1	(d)	This section shall apply to beaches:									
2	(1) Under the jurisdiction of the department, including										
3		private beaches in which the State has an easement or									
4	other property interest; and										
5	(2) Within a county with a population of more than:										
6		(A) Nine hundred thousand; or									
7		(B) One hundred thousand but fewer than one hundred									
8		eighty thousand.									
9	This sect	ion shall not apply to private beaches in which the									
10	State has no property interest.										
11	(e)	As used in this section:									
12	"Com	mercial beach equipment" means recreational equipment									
13	for rent,	including chairs, umbrellas, surfboards, paddleboards,									
14	kayaks, a	nd other non-motorized watercraft equipment.									
15	"Pre	set" means to set up or have physically ready for use									
16	commercia	l beach equipment by a commercial vendor."									
17	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that									
18	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were									
19	begun bef	ore its effective date.									
20	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.									

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1	SECTION 4	1.	This	Act	shall	take	effect	on	June	30,	3000.

DLNR; Beaches; Commercial Beach Equipment; Presetting; Removal; Commercial Vendors

Description:

Prohibits commercial vendors from presetting commercial beach equipment on certain beaches under the jurisdiction of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, unless the customer is physically present. Requires commercial vendors to expeditiously remove commercial beach equipment after the customer has finished using it. Allows the Department of Land and Natural Resources to grant exemptions through rules. Establishes administrative fines for violations. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD2)
