BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 171-58, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows:
3	"(h) This section shall not apply to the disposition of
4	water rights for the instream use of water for traditional and
5	customary kalo cultivation practices[\cdot], including commercial
6	kalo cultivation conducted in a manner consistent with
7	traditional and customary Native Hawaiian practices and on
8	traditional kalo lands."
9	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
