A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GENERAL FUND BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section
304A-2101(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, states, "[t]he general
fund budget appropriations for the university shall be an amount
not less than three times and not greater than five times the
amount of regular tuition and related fee revenues estimated for
that fiscal year."

The legislature further finds that, like many other 7 8 provisions of law facially requiring that a particular amount or 9 range of funds be appropriated, the language of section 10 304A-2101(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, does not mandate the 11 current legislature to appropriate funds of any amount because 12 one legislature may not bind a successor legislature. The legislature therefore concludes that the language in section 13 304A-2101(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, merely provides guidance 14 or an expression of intent from a previous legislature to the 15 16 current legislature regarding the general fund appropriation to

1	the University of Hawaii. Accordingly, to clarify the
2	appropriation process and to prevent future confusion, the
3	provision should be repealed.
4	The purpose of this Act is to repeal the provision
5	providing guidance on the legislature's appropriation to the
6	University of Hawaii.
7	SECTION 2. Section 304A-2101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"[[]§304A-2101[]] General fund budget [appropriations/]
10	appropriation formulation. [(a) The general fund budget
11	appropriations for the university shall be an amount not less
12	than three times and not greater than five times the amount of
13	regular tuition and related fee revenues estimated for that
14	fisdal year.
15	(b)] (a) Any general fund budget appropriation for the
16	university for operating purposes for any fiscal year shall
17	include the consideration of:
18	(1) The fiscal condition of the State;
19	(2) Enrollment;
20	(3) Access to educational opportunity;

1 (5) Community service and noninstruction programs. 2 [-(c)] (b) No revenue received by the university pursuant 3 to the University of Hawaii tuition and fees special fund 4 established under section [+]304A-2153[+] may be used by the 5 governor or the director of finance as a justification for 6 reducing any budget request or allotment to the university 7 unless the university requests such a reduction." 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023. 11
