RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue

4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024

10	SECT	ION 3. The sums appropriated for the respec	tive
11	capital p	rojects set forth in section 1 shall be expe	nded by the
12	designate	d expending agency for the purposes of this	Act as
13	follows:		
14	(1)	The sums appropriated in items 1, 3, 4, 5,	6, 7, 8, 9,
15		and 11 shall be expended by the department	of
16		education;	
17	(2)	The sums appropriated in item 2 shall be ex	pended by
18		the department of land and natural resource	s; and
19	(3)	The sum appropriated in item 10 shall be ex	pended by
20		the University of Hawaii.
