SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS TO IDENTIFY STATE JOB CLASSIFICATIONS FOR WHICH A DEGREE OR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE FROM A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY SUBSTITUTE FOR AN ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE.

WHEREAS, community college career and technical education 1 programs and community college degree programs integrate 2 academic skills and hands-on training to ensure that students 3 are well prepared to enter the workforce; and 4 5 WHEREAS, these programs help students become well-rounded 6 individuals, citizens, and employees by emphasizing major 7 academic subjects, communication skills, and pollical and social 8 responsibility; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, these programs have proven successful for students who thrive in less traditional learning environments, allowing 12 them to see the immediate relevance and real-world applications 13 14 of their education; and 15 16 WHEREAS, community college career and technical education programs and community college degree programs create 17 opportunities and provide options for individuals with 18 disabilities, individuals from economically disadvantaged 19 families, homeless individuals, and others who might otherwise 20 be unemployed or underemployed; and 21 22 WHEREAS, a degree or Career and Technical Education 23 Certificate from a community college indicates a student's 24 preparedness for employment and are in many ways comparable to 25 an Associate of Arts degree; now, therefore, 26 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 29 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 30 Labor and Industrial Relations is urged to identify state job 31

classifications for which a degree or Career and Technical 1 Education Certificate from a community college may substitute 2 for an Associate of Arts degree; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in identifying these state job 5 classifications, the Department of Labor and Industrial 6 Relations is requested to work with Hawaii P-20, a partnership 7 8 lead by the Executive Office on Early Learning, Department of Education, and University of Hawaii System; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Labor and 11 Industrial Relations is requested to emphasize general 12 qualifications in its job listings, such as those relating to 13 skills, work experience, and industry credentials that may 14 substitute for an associate of arts degree; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Labor and 17 Industrial Relations is requested to submit a report of its 18 findings and recommendations to the Legislature no later than 19 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 20 2024; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Labor 24 and Industrial Relations, Chairperson of the Board of Education, 25 Superintendent of Education, and State Director for Career and 26 27 Technical Education. 28 29 30 OFFERED BY:
