## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT TO REEXAMINE THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR VACANT STATE POSITIONS AND REPLACE THE REQUIREMENT OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE WITH AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE OR CERTIFICATE, WHERE APPLICABLE.

1	WHEREAS, there are more than six thousand vacant positions
2 3	within state government; and
4	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to fill
5	these vacant positions with qualified individuals, as doing so
6	will:

8	(1) Directly and positively impact the availability and
9	quality of customer service provided to the public
10	through state agencies; and
11 12	(2) Provide stable careers with steady income to the
12	people of Hawaii; and

15	WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources Development has
16	not conducted a review to verify the applicability of the
17	qualifications required for these positions; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, some of the vacant positions require a bachelor's
20	degree despite the degree being irrelevant to or unnecessary for
21	the performance of the duties of these positions; and
22 23	WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations,
23 24	in partnership with the University of Hawaii Honolulu Community
25	College, offers apprenticeship programs that prepare
26	participants to enter and advance in various trades; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, apprenticeship programs:

30	<ol> <li>Provide a participant on-the-job learning and</li> </ol>
31	development of technical and nontechnical skills and

proficiencies applicable to today's workplace and 1 2 necessary for the participant's future occupation; 3 4 (2) Evaluate the apprentice's acquisition of skills based upon a specified number of hours of on-the-job 5 6 learning and the successful demonstration of 7 competency, as described in the work process schedule; 8 and 9 (3) Upon satisfactory completion, may lead to an associate 10 degree or certificate of completion; now, therefore, 11 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 14 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 15 Human Resources Development is urged to reexamine the 16 qualifications for vacant state positions and replace the 17 18 requirement of a bachelor's degree with an associate degree or 19 certificate, where applicable; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human 22 Resources Development, in collaboration with the Department of 23 Labor and Industrial Relations, is urged to consider and determine whether the completion of an apprenticeship program 24 25 would adequately equip an individual with the skills and knowledge necessary for state employment; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human 29 Resources Development is requested to submit a report to the Legislature by January 1, 2024, detailing state positions for 30 which job qualifications were amended; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director 34 35 of Human Resources Development, and Director of Labor and Industrial Relations. 36 37 38 39 OFFERED BY:
