SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO TRANSFER THE SCHOOL OF
TRAVEL INDUSTRY MANAGEMENT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT
MANOA TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII - WEST OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, the School of Travel Industry Management in the
2 University of Hawaii at Manoa's Shidler College of Business was
3 once ranked among the top twenty college programs in the nation
4 for hospitality management; and

6 WHEREAS, in 2022, the School of Travel Industry Management
7 had dropped in ranking to being among the top fifty college
8 programs in the nation for hospitality management; and

10 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii - West Oahu was developed
11 to address workforce needs and leverage modern technologies to
12 train the next generation of community leaders; and

14 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii - West Oahu is the
15 fastest growing campus within the University of Hawaii system;

18 WHEREAS, there is a growing need for employees in the
19 hospitality industry on the Leeward Coast of Oahu as more hotels
20 develop in that region; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the
24 House of Representatives concurring, that the University of
25 Hawaii is requested to transfer the School of Travel Industry
26 Management from the University of Hawaii at Manoa to the
27 University of Hawaii - West Oahu; and
