## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE STATE TO BUILD A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND COLLABORATE ON SIMILAR, SHARED CHALLENGES AND GOALS.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to 1 2 cultivate meaningful relationships with countries and 3 subnational governments to collaborate on solutions to shared challenges; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Netherlands is a northwestern European country 6 7 notable for its economic, cultural, and ecological contributions to world history; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Hawaii and the Netherlands are very similar in 10 11 both challenges faced and shared values; and 12 13 WHEREAS, similar to Hawaii, the Netherlands is especially 14 vulnerable to the effects of climate change; and 15 WHEREAS, with seventeen percent of its land having been 16 reclaimed from bodies of water, the Netherlands is particularly 17 threatened by sea level rise and flooding brought on by global 18 warming; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, throughout its history, the Netherlands has developed inventive land reclamation and flood mitigation 22 strategies that could be used to defend the State from impending 23 catastrophic sea level rise; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, the Netherlands is renowned for its innovative and productive agricultural practices that could be useful to the 27 28 State in promoting local farms; and 29 WHEREAS, the Netherlands has pioneered transportation 30 solutions that have reduced costs, curbed emissions, and 31

improved safety that could also be advantageous to the State 1 2 given the current challenges to Hawaii's future; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Hawaii and the Netherlands are both members of the Local2030 Islands Network and are committed to the same 5 sustainable development goals; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, similar to Hawaii, the Netherlands is a center of 9 cultural and commercial exchange; and 10 WHEREAS, as a result, Hawaii and the Netherlands both 11 12 highly value social tolerance, gender equality, and the promotion of LGBTQ+ rights; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, given the similarities between the State and the Netherlands, fostering a relationship with the Netherlands would 16 17 be beneficial; now, therefore, 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 20 House of Representatives concurring, that this body encourages 21 22 the State to build a partnership with the Kingdom of the Netherlands and collaborate on the similar, shared challenges 23 24 and goals; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 28 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.
