SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE ON AGING TO DEVELOP A STANDARD TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR KUPUNA AND CAREGIVERS ON HOW TO SELECT AND PURCHASE APPROPRIATE BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY EQUIPMENT, AUDIO VISUAL EQUIPMENT SUCH AS TABLETS, AND HOW TO OPERATE EQUIPMENT TO ACCESS TELEHEALTH SERVICES.

1 WHEREAS, over seven million low-income seniors in America are enrolled in Medicaid for their health coverage; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic 4 has changed the way many people access health care, making 5 online doctor visits a more common occurrence; and 6 7 WHEREAS, telehealth and online doctor visits can increase 8 access to health care for the most vulnerable populations, 9 including those enrolled in Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries; 10 and 11 12 WHEREAS, technologies to increase access to care and health 13 outcomes, especially for kupuna and residents in rural areas of 14 the State, are limited due to lack of access to broadband 15 internet or unfamiliarity with computers and advancing 16 17 technologies; and 18 19 WHEREAS, modern equipment such as tablets provide a simple 20 interface tailored to high-risk and older patients by featuring brighter screens and larger icons; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Executive Office on Aging is the designated 23 lead agency in the coordination of a statewide system of aging 24 25 and caregiver support services in the State; now, therefore, 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 28 29 House of Representatives concurring, that the Executive Office 30 on Aging is urged to develop a standard training workshop for

kupuna and caregivers on how to select and purchase appropriate 1 broadband connectivity equipment, audio visual equipment such as 2 3 tablets, and how to operate equipment to access telehealth services; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that curriculum topics for the 6 standard training workshop are requested to include: 7 8 (1) Establishing a reasonable budget related to broadband 9 10 access; and 11 12 (2) Identifying reputable contractors in the area to install and maintain broadband equipment; and 13 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Executive Office on Aging. 17 18 19 OFFERED BY: Gut M.
