SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES' MED-QUEST DIVISION TO ADVOCATE THAT THE STATE INCREASE MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENTS TO DENTISTS AND, UPON AN INCREASE APPROVAL, TO PROACTIVELY INFORM BOTH DENTAL SERVICE PROVIDERS AND MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES OF NEW RATE PLANS.

WHEREAS, preventative dental cleanings and early treatment 1 2 result in a lower cost to the State's health care system than 3 emergency room treatment; and 4 WHEREAS, many of the State's low-income residents delay 5 dental care, ultimately resulting in their turning to emergency 6 rooms, which can only stabilize patients and are unable to do 7 more specialized dentistry procedures that patients often need; 8 and 9 10 WHEREAS, the Executive Supplemental Budget for fiscal year 11 2023 allocated over \$25,000,000 to the Department of Human 12 Services' Med-QUEST Division to expand services, including 13 restoring full dental benefits for adults; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the Governor announced that his proposed budget 16 seeks \$25,000,000 for fiscal year 2024 and \$20,000,000 for 17 fiscal year 2025 to increase Medicaid reimbursement rates up to 18 one hundred percent of Medicare reimbursement rates; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the expanded Med-QUEST dental benefits include 21 basic preventative services such as teeth cleaning, x-rays, and 22 exams and basic restoration procedures for chewing functions, 23 fillings, and crowns; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, Medicaid beneficiaries should be informed of the restoration of benefits so they can receive proper dental care; 27 now, therefore, 28 29



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BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 1 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 2 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 3 Human Services' Med-QUEST Division is urged to advocate that the 4 State increase Medicaid reimbursements to dentists and, upon an 5 increase approval, proactively inform both dental service 6 providers and Medicaid beneficiaries of new rate plans and 7 covered services; and 8 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human 11 12 Services.
