SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO UPDATE ITS MISSION STATEMENT TO INCLUDE LOCAL FOOD PRODUCTION TO SUPPLY LOCAL COMMUNITY CONSUMPTION, AND TO FEATURE THE MISSION STATEMENT MORE PROMINENTLY ON ITS WEBSITE AND APPROPRIATE PUBLICATIONS.

WHEREAS, the current mission of the Department of 1 Agriculture is to promote the conservation, development, and 2 utilization of agricultural resources in the State; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the mission of supporting an expanding local 5 agriculture sector is essential to the overall viability of the 6 State's economy and yet, is not included in the Department's 7 mission statement; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the challenges to the food supply chain and losses 10 of regular market sales for farmers and ranchers in the State 11 during the coronavirus 2019 pandemic highlighted the importance 12 of supporting local food production to specifically meet local 13 consumption demands; and 14 15 WHEREAS, local agriculture in the State currently generates 16 about \$500 million in farm-gate revenues annually and provides 17 thousands of jobs statewide and, when the economic value of 18 other agriculture related industries are considered, the total 19 20 value of agriculture jumps to nearly \$3 billion a year and provides approximately forty-two thousand jobs statewide; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, local agriculture contributes to a desired physical environment for both residents and visitors and 24 promotes economic as well as social well-being in rural 25 26 districts across the State; and 27 WHEREAS, the State and the people of Hawaii will benefit 28 from the explicit assertion and prioritization of local 29

agriculture production by the Department of Agriculture; now, 1 2 therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 6 Agriculture is requested to update its mission statement to 7 8 incorporate new language as follows: 9 "To serve Hawaii citizens by promoting and enhancing all 10 agriculture; protecting a safe, healthy food supply for 11 local consumption; and expanding local and global 12 agricultural trade. This will be accomplished through 13 efficient management, innovation, resource access, 14 infrastructure development, and sound science for all 15 agriculture with a balanced commitment to the needs of 16 agribusiness, environmental, and cultural stewardship."; 17 and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 20 is requested to feature its mission statement more prominently 21 on its website and uniformly in its publications; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 24 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 25 Board of Agriculture. 26 27 OFFERED BY: Hent Kutu 28 P 29
