SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAIIAN HUMANE SOCIETY TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM TO ASSIST LOW-INCOME PET OWNERS AFFORD EMERGENCY CARE FOR THEIR PETS.

WHEREAS, there are many health benefits of pet ownership 1 such as increased opportunities to exercise and companionship, 2 that can have physical and mental health benefits; and 3 4 WHEREAS, pets can help their human owners manage loneliness 5 and depression; and 6 7 WHEREAS, keeping a pet healthy by making regular visits to 8 a veterinarian and by purchasing preventative medication can be 9 10 expensive, costing between \$200 and \$400 per visit; and 11 WHEREAS, if a pet has a medical condition, the cost of a 12 13 veterinary visit can be much higher, upwards of \$1,000 for 14 emergency treatment or procedures; and 15 WHEREAS, due to the high cost of certain treatments, 16 financially insecure families may delay necessary treatments for 17 18 their pets, incur credit card debt, or turn to fundraising websites such as GoFundMe or Waqqle to pay for treatment; and 19 20 WHEREAS, these families should not have to choose between 21 the health of their beloved pet or delaying treatment or 22 incurring high interest debt; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 26 House of Representatives concurring, that the Hawaiian Humane 27 Society is requested to develop a program to assist low-income 28 pet owners provide emergency medical care for their pets; and 29 30

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program is requested to 1 include no or low-interest payment plans, no credit checks, and 2 3 other financial assistance options for uninsured pet owners; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaiian Humane Society is requested to submit a report of its findings and 6 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 7 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 8 the Regular Session of 2024; and 9 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 12 Hawaiian Humane Society. 13 14 15 16 OFFERED BY: Children
