SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES TO CREATE A PATHWAY TO CREATING A PROCESS UNDER SECTION 201H-38, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, FOR HOUSING PROJECTS THAT ARE EXCLUSIVELY AVAILABLE TO HAWAII RESIDENTS WHO WOULD BE OWNER- OR RENTER-OCCUPANTS AND WHO OWN NO OTHER REAL PROPERTY.

1 WHEREAS, the State is experiencing an unprecedented housing 2 crisis; and 3

4 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 5 Corporation (HHFDC) has a mission to oversee affordable housing 6 projects in the State through the development and financing of 7 low- and moderate-income housing projects and homeownership 8 programs; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to existing administrative rules, HHFDC 11 requires certain housing projects to offer half of the available 12 units to buyers whose income is at or below one hundred forty 13 percent of the area median income; and

WHEREAS, section 201H-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 15 authorizes certain exemptions from statutes, ordinances, charter 16 provisions, and rules relating to planning, zoning, development 17 and improvement of land, and construction standards for certain 18 19 housing projects developed by HHFDC or with an eligible developer under a government assistance program, defined as any 20 housing program qualified by HHFDC and administered or operated 21 22 by HHFDC or the United States, or any of their political subdivisions, agencies, or instrumentalities, corporate or 23 otherwise; and 24 25

26 WHEREAS, housing projects eligible for an exemption under 27 section 201H-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, must meet the 28 following criteria: 29



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- (1) The housing project is consistent with the purpose and 1 2 intent of chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and 3 meets minimum requirements of health and safety; 4 (2) The proposed housing project does not contravene 5 health or safety standards or Public Utilities 6 Commission or county boards of water supply, tariffs, 7 8 rates, or fees; and 9 The legislative body of the county in which the 10 (3) housing project is located approves the project with 11 or without modifications, and the land use commission 12 makes a determination on any boundary changes, under 13 14 certain conditions; and 15 WHEREAS, residential units at all price points are needed 16 to solve the chronic housing shortage for residents; now, 17 18 therefore, 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 20 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 21 22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Hawaii Housing 23 Finance and Development Corporation is urged to adopt administrative rules to create a pathway to the housing creation 24 25 process under section 201H-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for housing projects that are exclusively available to Hawaii 26 27 residents who would be owner- or renter-occupants and who own no 28 other real property; and 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Housing Finance and 30 Development Corporation is urged to adopt administrative rules 31 32 that create a second pathway to the housing creation process 33 under section 201H-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for housing projects that are exclusively available to Hawaii residents who 34 would be owner- or rental-occupants and who own no other real 35 property, which is requested to be in addition to existing 36 pathways under Hawaii Administrative Rules, that require 37 one-half of all units in a housing project to be available for 38 39 buyers whose income is at or below one hundred forty percent of the area median income; and 40 41



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 1 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Executive 2 Director of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 3 Corporation; Chairperson of the Hawaii Housing Finance and 4 Development Corporation Board of Directors; Chief Housing 5 Officer; and Director of Business, Economic Development, and 6 7 Tourism. 8 9 10
