6	the lifestyle for residents, either commercially as a food

9	WHEREAS, because reef and inshore fishing had greatly
10	deteriorated in the State as a result of excessive taking of
11	fish in coastal waters, Act 192, Session Laws of Hawaii 1955,
12	was enacted to allow for the designation of marine life
13	conservation districts; and

15	WHEREAS, marine life conservation districts are designed to
16 17	conserve and replenish marine resources by limiting fishing and
17 18	other consumptive uses or prohibiting such uses entirely; and
10 19	WHEREAS, under existing law, marine life conservation
20	districts are established by the Department of Land and Natural
21	Resources; and

23	WHEREAS, there are ten existing marine life conservation
24	districts in the State as follows: Hanauma Bay, O'ahu; Pūpūkea,
25	Oʻahu; Waikīkī, Oʻahu; Kealakekua Bay, Hawaiʻi; Lapakahi, Hawaiʻi;
