SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ADOPT RULES FOR A PERMIT TO DISCHARGE POLLUTANTS THAT INCLUDE THE MAJOR FACTORS THAT ARE CONSIDERED IN IDENTIFYING THE FUNCTIONAL EQUIVALENT OF A DIRECT DISCHARGE FOR POINT SOURCES OR NON-POINT SOURCES.

WHEREAS, the Clean Water Act was enacted to regulate 1 pollution from point sources into surface waters by requiring a 2 permit through the National Pollutant Discharge System (NPDES); 3 that limits the pollutants that may be emitted by a point source 4 and the treatment steps that are necessary to limit those 5 pollutants; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court held that the 8 Clean Water Act requires a permit when pollutants originating 9 from a point source can be conclusively traced to navigable 10 waters via the "functional equivalent of a direct discharge"; 11 and 12 13 WHEREAS, determining "functional equivalent" is complicated 14 by factors such as: 15 16 Time and distance a pollutant travels; 17 (1) 18 (2) The nature of the material through which the pollutant 19 20 travels; and 21 22 (3) The extent to which the concentration of the pollutant changes as it travels; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Court elaborated that functional equivalent 25 permit determinations should preserve the authority of states to 26 regulate groundwater and other non-point sources of pollution; 27 and 28 29 WHEREAS, the Department of Health is responsible for 30 proposing rules defining "functional equivalent" relating to the 31



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discharge of pollutants that require a National Pollution 1 2 Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit; now, therefore, 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 4 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 6 Health use the ruling of the United States Supreme Court in 7 County of Maui v. Hawaii Wildlife Fund and guidelines 8 established by the Environmental Protection Agency to adopt 9 rules for a permit to discharge that include the major factors 10 that are considered in identifying, for point sources or non-11 12 point sources, "the functional equivalent of a direct discharge"; and 13 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health. 16 17 18 By Request 19 OFFERED BY:
