SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE MEMBERS OF HAWAII'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO MONITOR THE ALLIANCE FOR HIPPOCRATIC MEDICINE V. U.S. FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION AND TAKE ACTION TO LIMIT THE CASE FROM FURTHER RESTRICTING ACCESS TO SAFE ABORTION OPTIONS.

WHEREAS, in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, 1 142 S.Ct. 2228 (2022), the Supreme Court of the United States 2 overruled nearly fifty years of federal precedent on 3 reproductive rights, including Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973), 4 and Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pennsylvania v. Casey, 5 505 U.S. 833 (1992), by holding that the United States 6 Constitution does not provide a right to abortion and authority 7 to regulate abortion must be returned to the people and their 8 9 elected representatives; and 10 an Age th WHEREAS, the Dobbs decision opened the door for state 11 legislatures to enact a host of restrictions on reproductive 12 health options that were available pursuant to Roe; and 13 14 WHEREAS, following the Dobbs decision, various states have 15 taken steps to curtail or ban abortion outright, while the 16 federal government and other states have been taking actions to 17 protect access to abortion care services; and 18 19 WHEREAS, at a time when people across the country are 20 struggling to obtain abortion care services, it is critical that 21 access to medication abortion be available so that health care 22 providers have an additional method of providing a safe and 23 effective abortion treatment to their patients; and 24 25 WHEREAS, mifepristone is a drug that was first approved by 26 the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on 27 September 28, 2000, as a safe and effective drug that can be 28 used with the medicine misoprostol for medical termination of 29 pregnancy through seven weeks gestation, which was subsequently 30 extended to ten weeks gestation in 2016; and 31

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1 WHEREAS, in the United States District Court for The 2 Northern District of Texas, the case of The Alliance for 3 Hippocratic Medicine et al. v. U.S. Food and Drug 4 Administration, et al., Case No. 2:22-cv-00223-Z (Alliance), 5 involves plaintiffs seeking to overturn the FDA's approval of 6 7 mifepristone; and 8 WHEREAS, the ruling in Alliance could effectively ban 9 mifepristone nationwide and bar health care providers from 10 prescribing mifepristone even in states where abortion is legal, 11 which would result in severe consequences on people's ability to 12 access critical abortion and miscarriage health care; now, 13 therefore, 14 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 16 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 17 House of Representatives concurring, the members of Hawaii's 18 congressional delegation are urged to monitor the Alliance case 19 20 currently pending before the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas and take action to limit the case 21 from further restricting access to safe abortion; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the members of Hawaii's 25 congressional delegation. 26 27 28 the share 29 OFFERED BY

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
