SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE REGULATION AND LICENSURE OF ASSOCIATE PHYSICIANS.

WHEREAS, persons who have graduated from an accredited 1 medical school but who have not been accepted to a medical 2 residency program are not eligible to be licensed to practice 3 medicine in the State; and 4 5 , introduced during the 2023 Regular WHEREAS, S.B. No. 6 Session, proposes the authorization of associate physicians to 7 practice medicine in the State and the regulation and licensure 8 of associate physicians; and 9 10 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 11 new measures subjecting unregulated professions and vocations to 12 licensing or other regulatory controls to be referred to the 13 Auditor for analysis; and 14 15 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, further 16 requires that referral to the Auditor shall be by a concurrent 17 resolution that identifies a specific legislative bill to be 18 19 analyzed; now, therefore; 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 22 House of Representatives concurring, that in accordance with 23 section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Auditor is 24 25 respectfully requested to conduct a sunrise review of the licensure of associate physicians proposed by S.B. No. 26 , Regular Session of 2023; and 27 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any 30 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty 31 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and 32 33
