## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF WIDENING THE PORTION OF UNIVERSITY AVENUE BETWEEN MAILE WAY AND OAHU AVENUE.

WHEREAS, Manoa Valley is a residential neighborhood of 1 Honolulu and has eighteen thousand six hundred households, a 2 population of 46,865, and a non-resident workforce of 25,230; 3 4 and 5 6 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley is also home to the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Mid-Pacific Institute, Noelani and Manoa 7 8 elementary schools, four private schools, sixty-three general businesses, eighteen clubs and associations, twenty-five 9 community service entities, eighteen faith-based organizations, 10 fourteen health care centers, fourteen nonprofit organizations, 11 12 and nine kupuna care centers; and 13 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley ingress and egress is limited to two 14 roads: Manoa Road and University Avenue; and 15 16 WHEREAS, each day, bicycles and motor vehicles, including 17 18 buses, firetrucks, ambulances, commercial vehicles, and passenger vehicles, travel on University Avenue, creating a 19 significant traffic safety concern; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley contains three heavily used hiking 22 trails, Manoa Falls trail, Puu Pia trail, and Kolowalu trail, 23 24 resulting in the valley being Oahu's second most frequented destination by visitors and residents, further exacerbating 25 traffic congestion throughout the valley; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Manoa Valley District Park, the second most used 28 city park on Oahu, hosts a myriad of events; sports activities 29

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such as baseball, softball, soccer, tennis, pickleball, 1 volleyball, basketball, and swimming; summer fun programs; 2 senior citizen programs; open markets; community gardening; and 3 4 disaster preparedness programs; and 5 6 WHEREAS, there exists an immediate need to improve traffic 7 safety throughout Manoa Valley; and 8 9 WHEREAS, one possible way to alleviate traffic congestion 10 and improve traffic safety in Manoa Valley is to widen the portion of University Avenue between Maile Way and Oahu Avenue; 11 now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 14 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 15 16 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is 17 urged to conduct a feasibility study of widening the portion of 18 University Avenue between Maile Way and Oahu Avenue; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of 21 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is 22 also requested to submit a report of its findings and 23 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 24 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 25 the regular session of 2024; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 28 29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of 30 31 Honolulu. 32 33 OFFERED BY: Charl Julianage 34



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
