SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS AND OTHER TRAFFIC CALMING STRUCTURES ON ALA AOLANI STREET IN MOANALUA VALLEY AND OTHER SURROUNDING STREETS DEEMED APPROPRIATE TO DETER SPEEDING.

1 WHEREAS, Moanalua Valley is a residential area that is home
2 to several thousand residents and also includes a golf course,
3 neighborhood park, popular hiking trail, and nearby entrance and
4 exit to Interstate H-201; and

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6 WHEREAS, Ala Aolani Street is the main roadway in the area
7 that is utilized by pedestrians, bicyclists, and resident and
8 visitor drivers; and

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10 WHEREAS, many residents in the area have recently expressed
11 concerns about speeding on Ala Aolani Street, which has a speed
12 limit of twenty-five miles per hour; and

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14 WHEREAS, the increase in speeding in the area has increased
15 the risk of harm to drivers, passengers, bicyclists, and
16 pedestrians on other roadways in the area such as Ala Hoku
17 Place; and

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19 WHEREAS, traffic calming is a method used to regulate
20 speeding by managing the flow of traffic using physical designs
21 and devices, including narrow lanes, speed bumps, speed tables,
22 raised crosswalks and intersections, and roundabouts; and

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24 WHEREAS, because traffic safety is of paramount importance
25 to residents and visitors alike, implementation of more
26 effective methods of regulating speeding and enforcing speed



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1 limits, including traffic calming systems, is necessary; now,
2 therefore,

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4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the
6 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
7 Transportation, in coordination with the Department of
8 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu, is
9 requested to install speed bumps and other traffic calming
10 structures on Ala Aolani Street in Moanalua Valley and other
11 surrounding streets deemed appropriate to deter speeding; and

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13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
15 Transportation and Director of the Department of Transportation
16 Services of the City and County of Honolulu.
