REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF ALL THE PROGRAMS WITHIN THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources' 1 2 State Historic Preservation Division serves to protect and preserve historic properties significant to Hawaii's history 3 through several program areas; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Division has 6 indicated that it has faced challenges with insufficient 7 staffing and funding, which hinder its ability to carry out its 8 important duties and responsibilities in a timely manner; and 9 10 WHEREAS, under section 23-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the 11 Auditor may examine and inspect all accounts, books, records, 12 files, papers, and documents and all financial affairs of every 13 department, office, agency, and political subdivision; 14 now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 17 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 18 that the Auditor is requested to conduct a performance audit of 19 all the programs within the State Historic Preservation Division 20 21 of the Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the performance audit is 23 24 requested to include but not be limited to: 25 An evaluation of whether the review and response to 26 (1) submittals is completed within the timeframes 27 established by rule; 28 29 (2) Current project review practices, including efforts to 30 identify categorical exemptions; historic properties 31 and districts that should have special protections or 32 treatment; identification of types of sites that do 33
