SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR KETAMINE THERAPY FOR QUALIFYING PATIENTS.

WHEREAS, the State has a duty to protect and improve the 1 health and environment of the people; and 2 3 WHEREAS, a number of state residents suffer from 4 5 depression; and 6 7 WHEREAS, according to an article published in Current 8 Neuropharmacology, the use of ketamine is a valid antidepressant option for the treatment of treatment-resistant depression, and 9 has rapid antidepressant effects; and 10 11 WHEREAS, ketamine therapy would bring relief to many state 12 residents who suffer from depression; now, therefore, 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 15 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 16 that beginning on January 1, 2024, the State's Medicaid programs 17 are requested to provide coverage for percent of the costs 18 of ketamine therapy to treat depression in qualifying patients, 19 20 as determined by qualified psychiatrists or other mental health professionals; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each individual or group 23 accident and health or sickness insurance policy issued or 24 25 renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2024, is requested 26 to provide to the policyholder and individuals covered under the percent of the costs of ketamine therapy 27 policy coverage for 28 to treat depression in qualifying patients, as determined by qualified psychiatrists or other mental health professionals; 29 30 and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each hospital or medical 32 service plan contract issued or renewed in this State on or 33 after January 1, 2024, is requested to provide to the member and 34 individuals covered under the plan contract coverage 35 for percent of the costs of ketamine therapy to treat 36



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depression in qualifying patients, as determined by qualified 1 psychiatrists or other mental health professionals; and 2

3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 5 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human Services and the Insurance Commissioner, the latter of whom is requested to 6 distribute copies of this measure to the entities administering 7 8 the insurance policies and service plan contracts addressed in 9 this measure. 10
