SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON REDEVELOPING LANDS SITUATED AT TMK (1) 2-8-015:001 INTO WORKFORCE HOUSING AND OTHER AFFILIATED USES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Business, Economic Development, 1 and Tourism estimates that Hawaii will need between 2 approximately twenty-six thousand to forty-seven thousand new 3 4 housing units prior to 2030 to address the critical shortage of housing; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the continuing lack of sufficient supply or 7 inventory of workforce housing will worsen the shortage of 8 housing every year as the demand for housing will continue to 9 grow more rapidly than new supply is available; and 10 11 WHEREAS, if the State fails to address this housing crisis 12 more residents will be forced to move away from Hawaii to obtain 13 housing they can afford; and 14 15 WHEREAS, state agencies could help to address the housing 16 crisis by providing suitable lands available for the development 17 of affordable housing, including workforce housing, on 18 properties that those agencies are planning to redevelop; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, providing concepts and plans publicly as early as possible would be very helpful and useful to programs and 22 organizations that currently utilize TMK (1) 2-8-015:001 as well 23 as surrounding properties; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 26 27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, that the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation, or 28 any other appropriate state agency, is requested to conduct a 29 feasibility study on redeveloping lands situated at TMK (1) 2-8-30 015:001 into workforce housing and other affiliated uses; and 31 32

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the feasibility study is 1 requested to be conducted in cooperation with any appropriate 2 state agency that will be affected by the study or may be 3 instrumental in completing the study; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Housing Finance and 6 Development Corporation, or any other appropriate state agency, 7 is requested to include in the study a conceptual development 8 plan that may include a market study to redevelop the parcel, 9 along with the steps needed for such development; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Housing Finance and 12 Development Corporation, or any other appropriate state agency, 13 is requested to submit a report on the feasibility study to the 14 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 15 the Regular Session of 2025; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 18 19 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Executive Director of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 20 Corporation, President of the University of Hawaii, and any 21 director of state agency who helped to complete the report. 22 23 24 25

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
