SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND ALL COUNTY TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENTS TO INSTALL DESIGNATIONS OF "DO NOT BLOCK" AND RELATED SIGNAGE AT HIGH TRAFFIC INTERSECTIONS.

WHEREAS, Act 54, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, requires the 1 Department of Transportation and county transportation 2 departments to adopt "Complete Streets" policies that provide 3 safe access and mobility for all users of public roadways; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, traffic congestion is most prevalent at busy intersections when drivers misjudge traffic light signals or 7 disregard traffic laws, thereby blocking the intersection and 8 9 preventing the normal flow of traffic; and 10 WHEREAS, when drivers block intersections, including 11 crosswalks, dangerous situations can occur, creating safety 12 hazards for pedestrians; bicyclists, individuals using personal 13 assistive mobility devices, and other motorists; and 14 15 WHEREAS, heavy traffic congestion at high traffic 16 intersections can be addressed through engineering and design 17 practices with education and enforcement to improve driver 18 awareness and behavior; and 19 20

21 WHEREAS, the creation of additional markings and signage, 22 including paint lines on roadways in high traffic intersections, 23 may improve heavy traffic congestion and driver education and 24 awareness, and promote safety for all roadway users; now, 25 therefore,

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 28 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 29 that the Department of Transportation and all county 30 transportation departments are requested to install designations 31 of "Do Not Block" and related signage at high traffic 32 intersections; and
