Sir:

Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred S.B. No. 1377 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION CONTROL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to revise chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to:

- (1) Add wetlands to the definition of "state waters";
- (2) Clarify the Director of Health's role as a certifying agency including enforcement of water quality certifications; and
- (3) Increase certain statutory civil penalties.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Health and Hawai'i Reef and Ocean Coalition.

Your Committee finds that the Department of Health has been authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to administer the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Program and the section 401 Water Quality Certification Program of the federal Clean Water Act. Your Committee further finds that this authority has been incorporated into chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS). Your Committee finds that to effectively

administer these programs, the definitions and penalties in chapter 342D, HRS, must be consistent with the regulations of the Clean Water Act. Therefore, this measure revises chapter 342D, HRS, to add wetlands to the definition of "state waters", clarifies the Director of Health's role as a certifying agency and enforcer of water quality certifications, and increases certain statutory civil penalties.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting an effective date of July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
  - (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 1377, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 1377, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committees on Judiciary and Ways and Means.
