"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES FOR IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN WAR VETERANS,"

The purpose and intent of this measure is to create license plates to honor veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of Veterans' Services of the Department of Defense and one individual.

Your Committees find that veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts have sacrificed their lives to defend the citizens of the United States. Existing law does not include special license plates for Iraq and Afghanistan veterans, therefore, this measure will create license plates to honor the veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts.
