and two individuals.


Your Committee finds that many people with disabilities rely
on accessible public transit to participate in education,
employment, health care, housing, and community life. Lack of
accessible transportation is a significant barrier to community
participation for many people with disabilities. Your Committee
further finds that people living in rural areas face additional
transportation barriers, such as longer travel distances and
limited public transit options. Your Committee therefore finds
that this measure focuses on improving public transit in Oahu's
rural communities.
