Your Committee on Public Safety and Intergovernmental and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.R. No. 111 entitled:

"SENATE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE HAWAII EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT AGENCY ESTABLISH A TWO-YEAR TASK FORCE TO ADDRESS
KEY FINDINGS VALIDATED BY THE 2022 RESILIENCY ASSESSMENT
REPORT OF THE HAWAII MARITIME TRANSPORTATION REGIONAL
RESILIENCY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM PROJECT AND PLAN RESILIENCY
ENHANCEMENTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request the
Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, in conjunction with the
Harbors Division of the Department of Transportation, to establish
a two-year task force to address the key findings of the July 2022
Resiliency Assessment report of the Hawaii Maritime Transportation
Regional Resiliency Assessment Program Project and plan for
related resiliency enhancements.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Hawai'i Emergency Management Agency and Department of
Transportation.

Your Committee finds that Hawaii's maritime transportation
system is vital to the State's supply chains, with the port of
Honolulu being a crucial part of the maritime transportation
system. Approximately eighty percent of all inbound products move




through the port of Honolulu, and any prolonged interruption of the port's operation could quickly create severe commodity shortages and cascading consequences for the State. Your Committee further finds that the Regional Resiliency Assessment Program's (RRAP) Resiliency Assessment report found that Hawaii will need to update and create a robust alternative port and Reverse Hub and Spoke plan and consider significant investments in resiliency-related infrastructure upgrades across the State. Your Committee believes that addressing the key findings in the Resiliency Assessment report and planning resiliency enhancements will better inform the State and its key maritime stakeholders regarding alternate emergency maritime options. This measure will assist in the creation of more robust plans to ensure the quality of critical infrastructure and allow the State to better prepare for, respond to, and recover from a catastrophic incident affecting maritime transportation systems.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.R. No. 111, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as S.R. No. 111, S.D. 1.
