Extends under certain conditions, the family leave period for up to eight weeks for employees who are unable to perform their employment duties due to the birth of a child who is required to stay in a neonatal intensive care unit. Requires the department of health to amend its rules to include neonatal care as a related medical condition wherever the phrase "pregnancy, childbirth, or other related condition" is used. RELATING TO EARLY CHILD CARE.

Requires the department of human services to establish and implement a two-year infant and toddler child care worker subsidy pilot program to assist in retaining the existing child care workforce. Appropriates funds for the pilot program. Sunsets 7/1/2025. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

RELATING TO BACKGROUND CHECKS.

Authorizes the department of human services to conduct background checks for current and prospective employees, volunteers, contractors, contractors' employees and volunteers, subcontractors, and subcontractors' employees and volunteers who are in positions that require close proximity to certain minors, young adults, or vulnerable adults. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD2)
