Mr. Lietzke, a Vice President at Booz Allen Hamilton, received a Bachelor of Science degree from the United States Air Force Academy and a Master of Science in Human Resource Management and Development from Chapman University.

Mr. Lietzke has more than 32 years combined active duty, reserve, and consulting experience covering many aspects of cyber security, infrastructure assurance, joint and combined exercises, immersive technologies, data analytics, and C4ISR simulations.

At Booz Allen Mr. Lietzke is assigned to the Global Defense Sector and supports technology, training, and general consulting business across the Indo-Pacific Region. He is applying his knowledge of cyber security, training modernization, and joint military operations to advance client missions in the Indo-Pacific. He provides strategic planning and development guidance to a variety of clients in the areas of cyber security, mission assurance, exercise and training, modeling and simulation, wargaming, and infrastructure protection. During his time with Booz Allen he directly managed support to two Department of Defense (DoD) Pilot Programs. First, the U.S. Pacific Command NetOps program where he assisted clients in developing situational awareness of the Global Information Grid (GIG) and understanding the operational impacts of disruptions to the GIG. Mr. Lietzke supported a second pilot in the USPACOM CIP Program. He and his team's efforts in support of this project helped develop capabilities focused understanding of infrastructure protection and were a leading influence in operationalizing CIP at the Combatant Command level. In addition, he currently manages a wide variety of client support projects in the areas of joint exercise and training, cyber operations, information assurance, and business resilience. In support of these engagements he is helping clients develop an enterprise wide approach to risk management and to focus on the convergence of capabilities in support of cyber security initiatives. Mr. Lietzke currently holds a Top Secret (TS) security clearance with SCI eligibility.

Mr. Lietzke serves as OIC for several multi-million dollar contract vehicles and has served in program management roles for more than two decades.

Before joining Booz Allen, Mr. Lietzke was a communications officer in the United States Air Force. He recently retired from the Air Force Reserves after serving as a Cyber Operations Officer and an Admissions Liaison Officer for the United States Air Force Academy.
