### In consideration of GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE 581 SUBMITTING FOR CONSIDERATION AND CONFIRMATION TO THE KĀNE'OHE BAY REGIONAL COUNCIL, GUBERNATORIAL NOMINEE, SYLVIA HUSSEY, FOR A TERM TO EXPIRE 06-30-2027

The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) supports Governor's Message 581 nominating Dr. Sylvia Hussey to the Kāne'ohe Bay Regional Council for a term to expire on June 30, 2027.

Pursuant to Section 200D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Kāne'ohe Bay Regional Council was established to, among other things, facilitate the implementation of the Kāne'ohe Bay Master Plan as it relates to ocean use activities and advise and make recommendations to the State and the County on matters regarding the use of Kāne'ohe Bay by the general public, marine research programs, and commercial ocean use activities, including legislative matters. Membership on the Council includes government officials, area neighborhood board members, and individuals representing user groups of the Bay.

Dr. Sylvia Hussey is the current Chief Executive Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA), a role she has held since 2019, and the owner of Pueo Consulting, LLC, a business formed to provide a broad range of statewide education and business support services in the areas of administration, management, leadership, and governance. Dr. Hussey has an extensive background in education, finance, and issues facing the Native Hawaiian community. She obtained her Doctor of Education from the University of Hawai'i, Mānoa in 2014 and worked for Kamehameha Schools from 2002-2014, serving as the Vice President of Administration from
