Aloha Chair Lee and Committee Members,

Thank you for allowing the opportunity to provide testimony on HB 541, HD1, which would require proper headlamp specifications for vehicle safety inspections. The Proposed SD1 would also allow vehicle registrations in cases in which the safety check has expired.

Headlights in newer cars are excessively bright and can cause glare for oncoming motorists.

In addition, current law can cause Catch 22 situations in which a vehicle is not allowed to be registered until a safety check is done, but a safety check can't be done until the vehicle is properly registered.
