COMMENTS FOR: H.B. 933, HD2, SD1 – RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACCESS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH PRINT DISABILITIES

Re: Testimony providing comments for HB 933, HD2, SD1

Aloha Honorable Chair, Vice-Chair, and Committee Members:

Thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony for House Bill 933, HD2, SD1, to appropriate funds to the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") to provide free telecommunication access to information for individuals with print disabilities.

Hawaiian Telcom appreciates the intent of this bill and believes the provision of state general funds for this program is a more suitable means of support over the original language that proposed to utilize the State Universal Service Fund ("State USF"). <u>The primary purpose of a State USF program should</u> continue to be the provision of affordable and reasonable rates for basic residential telecommunications <u>services</u>. Hawaiian Telcom is unaware of any other jurisdiction using its State USF program for this purpose Furthermore, the number of customers subscribing to landline phone services continues to decline each year, so adding another fee or charge to existing bills will cause customers to switch to alternate services. Therefore, state general funds are a more suitable source of revenue to provide free telecommunication access to information for individuals with print disabilities.

Hawaiian Telcom appreciates the opportunity to provide testimony on this bill.
