The Disability and Communication Access Board (DCAB) supports and offers comment on House Resolution 137 and House Concurrent Resolution 136 – Recognizing October 2 through October 6, 2023, and October 7 through October 11, 2024, as Digital Inclusion Week in the State of Hawaii.

Digital inclusion provides persons with disabilities access to digital technology, including broadband internet service. Broadband internet service for all should be affordable, especially for underserved communities to foster their economic development, increase job opportunities, enhance health care, and broaden educational opportunities.
