RE: Testimony for LTG 100 for the Informational Briefing: Tuesday, January 24, 2023

Overview

- A. Pursuant to Article V, Section 4, of the Hawaii State Constitution, the primary mission of the Lieutenant Governor is to act in place of the Governor in his absence. Accordingly, the Lieutenant Governor must keep abreast of the actions and issues regarding the Administration to ensure she can effectively carry out the necessary functions of the office during these absences. Pursuant to Section 26-1, Hawaii Revised Statues, another core function of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor is to serve as Secretary of State for intergovernmental relations. In this role, the Lieutenant Governor is charged with directing and performing a multitude of activities for the public, which are administrative and coordinative in nature. These activities include the processing of name changes, issuing apostilles and certifications, and selling state publications. Such fees are deposited into the general fund and do not go towards funding the operation of the Lieutenant Governor's Office. Last year (2022) the Office processed approximately 800 name changes, 6,785, apostilles, and 706 certifications.
- B. Although there were many challenges brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic, the office has opened its doors to the public and continues to intake and process name changes, issue apostilles and certifications, and sell state publications. The office is currently evaluating and working on ways to make these processes more efficient to better reach and serve the community.

Section 26-1 indicates that, "governor shall identify and direct other duties as necessary to the lieutenant governor." The Lieutenant Governor has been entrusted with pre-k expansion and broadband initiatives.

Federal Funds

C. The Office does not receive or expend federal funds.

Non-General Funds

D. The Office does not receive or expend non-general funds.

Budget Requests

- E. The Office of the Lieutenant Governor is requesting an operating budget that will continue to support statutory responsibilities, such as the processing of name changes, issuing apostilles and certifications, and selling state publications, and will also support the shift in expectations and goals beyond the day-to-day operations and responsibilities of the office. The Lieutenant Governor has been entrusted with areas of policy, including pre-k expansion and broadband, that require additional resources to execute.
- F. The Office of the Lieutenant Governor is requesting additional positions and funds to support the office's statutory responsibilities, initiatives, and assigned/entrusted policy areas. Since the change in administration, we have quickly learned of the importance and impact of our services on the community. The office is analyzing current workflows in an effort to create more efficient processes that will better serve those requiring our services. Additional positions and funds have been requested to assist with the current workload and modernization of these processes.

The Governor has entrusted the Lieutenant Governor with two major policy areas, pre-k expansion and broadband, and it is likely that additional policy areas will be added. To execute these initiatives efficiently and effectively, the office will require additional positions and funds. These positions will be responsible for leading, coordinating, and executing these areas of policy and any other initiatives that the Governor may assign/entrust to the Lieutenant Governor's Office.
