Re:	Testimony of the Hawai'i State Ethics Commission in SUPPORT of SB 1187

Aloha Chair Rhoads and Committee Members:

The Hawai'i State Ethics Commission ("Commission") **supports** SB 1187, which increases the post-employment restriction on former legislators from twelve months to twenty-four months.

Currently, the post-employment law¹ prohibits legislators from:

- 1) Representing any entity, for pay, before either house of the Legislature; and
- 2) Representing any entity, for pay, before <u>any</u> state agency, on any matter the legislator worked on while a legislator.

"Represent" means to "engage in direct communication" pursuant to Haw. Rev. Stat. § 84-18(g). Existing restrictions do not prohibit a legislator from "behind the scenes" work, such as drafting testimony for someone else's signature.

The Commission supports strong post-employment restrictions to maintain and improve the public's trust in state government. Legislators are uniquely in the public eye, and there is a logical reason to extend the existing restrictions to match the length of a typical representative term (2 years). Such a step would reduce the appearance of influence trading between a former legislator and a recent colleague.
