A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMITTEE FUNDRAISERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-342, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§11-342 Fundraiser; fundraiser event; notice of intent;
- 4 when prohibited. (a) No fundraiser shall be held unless a
- 5 notice of intent to hold the fundraiser is filed with the
- 6 commission setting forth the name and address of the person in
- 7 charge, the price per person, the date, hour, and place of the
- 8 fundraiser, and the method thereof.
- 9 (b) The person in charge of the fundraiser shall file the
- 10 notice with the commission prior to the fundraiser.
- 11 (c) During any regular session or special session of the
- 12 state legislature, including any extension of any regular
- 13 session or special session and any legislative recess days,
- 14 holidays, and weekends, no elected official shall hold a
- 15 fundraiser event.

- 1 "Elected official" means an individual who currently holds
- 2 an elected state or county office, including the governor,
- 3 lieutenant governor, state senator, state representative,
- 4 trustee of the office of Hawaiian affairs, county mayor, county
- 5 council member, county prosecuting attorney, and any individual
- 6 appointed to serve in any of the aforementioned offices.
- 7 "Fundraiser" means any function held for the benefit of a
- 8 candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate committee that
- 9 is intended or designed, directly or indirectly, to raise
- 10 contributions [for which the price or suggested contribution for
- 11 attending the function is more than \$25 per person.] for which
- 12 any price is charged or any contribution is suggested for
- 13 attending the function.
- 14 "Fundraiser event" means any function held for the benefit
- 15 of an elected official that is intended or designed, directly or
- 16 indirectly, to raise contributions for which any price is
- 17 charged or any contribution is suggested for attending the
- 18 function."
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 21 begun before its effective date.
