A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 11-322, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows: "§11-322 Organizational report, candidate committee. 3 4 The candidate committee organizational report shall include: 5 The committee's name and address, including web page (1)address, if any; 6 The candidate's name, address, and telephone number; (2)7 The office being sought by the candidate, district, 8 (3)9 and party affiliation; The chairperson's name and address and, if appointed, 10 (4)the deputy chairperson's name and address; 11 The treasurer's name and address and, if appointed, 12 (5)13 all deputy treasurers' names and addresses; The name and address of each depository institution in 14 (6)which the committee will maintain any of its accounts 15 and the applicable account number; and 16

3	(b) Any change in information previously reported in the
4	organizational report shall be electronically filed with the
5	commission within ten days of the change being brought to the
6	attention of the committee chairperson or treasurer.
7	(c) The commission shall publish on its website the names
8	of all candidates who have failed to:
9	(1) File the organizational report; or
10	(2) Correct a report within two weeks after the commission
11	provides a notice to correct."
12	SECTION 2. Section 11-323, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	"§11-323 Organizational report, noncandidate committee.
15	(a) The noncandidate committee organizational report shall
16	include:
17	(1) The committee's name, which shall incorporate the full
18	name of the sponsoring entity, if any. An acronym or
19	abbreviation may be used in other communications if
20	the acronym or abbreviation is commonly known or
21	clearly recognized by the general public. The

(7) A certification by the candidate and treasurer of the

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1		committee's name shall not include the name of a
2		candidate;
3	(2)	The committee's address, including web page address,
4		if any;
5	(3)	The area, scope, or jurisdiction of the committee;
6	(4)	The name and address of the committee's sponsoring
7		entity. If the committee does not have a sponsoring
8		entity, the committee shall specify the trade,
9		profession, or primary interest of contributors to the
10		committee;
11	(5)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and
12		principal place of business of the chairperson;
13	(6)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and
14		principal place of business of the treasurer and any
15		other officers;
16	(7)	An indication as to whether the committee was formed
17		to support or oppose a specific ballot question or
18		candidate and, if so, a brief description of the
19		question or the name of the candidate;
20	(8)	An indication as to whether the committee is a
21		political party committee;

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1	(9)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and			
2		principal place of business of the custodian of the			
3		books and accounts;			
4	(10)	The name and address of the depository institution in			
5		which the committee will maintain its campaign account			
6		and each applicable account number; and			
7	(11)	A certification by the chairperson and treasurer of			
8		the statements in the organizational report.			
9	(b)	Any change in information previously reported in the			
10	organizational report shall be electronically filed with the				
11	commission within ten days of the change being brought to the				
12	attention	of the committee chairperson or treasurer.			
13	<u>(c)</u>	The commission shall publish on its website the names			
14	of all no	ncandidate committees who have failed to:			
15	(1)	File the organizational report; or			
16	(2)	Correct a report within two weeks after the commission			
17		provides a notice to correct."
