## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds 2 to the University of Hawaii Pamantasan Council for three full-3 time equivalent (3.0 FTE) positions. 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$310,000 or so much 5 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 8 2024-2025 to fund the establishment of the following positions for the University of Hawaii Pamantasan Council: 9 10 (1)One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent faculty 11 position at Leeward community college; 12 (2)One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent faculty position at the University of Hawaii Maui college; and 13 One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent 14 (3) administrative, professional, and technical position 15 at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. 16

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 2 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 4 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 5 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 6 appropriations contained in H.B. No. 300, H.D. 1, S.D. 1,
- 7 C.D. 1, will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 8 for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be exceeded by \$1,063,767,367 or
- 9 10 per cent. In addition, the appropriations contained in this
- 10 Act will cause the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal
- 11 year 2023-2024 to be further exceeded by \$310,000 or 1 per cent.
- 12 The combined total amount of general fund appropriations
- 13 contained in only these two Acts will cause the state general
- 14 fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be
- 15 exceeded by \$1,064,077,367 or 11 per cent. The reasons for
- 16 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 17 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 19 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- addressed by this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
