A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING ON HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that affordable housing
- 2 credits have been utilized by the department of Hawaiian home
- 3 lands to provide affordable housing opportunities for its
- 4 beneficiaries at no cost to the State. This program allowed for
- 5 the purchase of additional land in a location that beneficiaries
- 6 were interested in but where the department had no land in the
- 7 area, and resulted in a reduction in the price of housing units
- 8 offered by homebuilders on Hawaiians home lands.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to extend the sunset dates for
- 10 the issuance of county affordable housing credits to the
- 11 department of Hawaiian home lands pursuant to Act 141, Session
- 12 Laws of Hawaii 2009, as amended, and Act 98, Session Laws of
- 13 Hawaii 2012, as amended, to July 1, 2030.
- 14 SECTION 2. Act 141, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as
- 15 amended by section 3 of Act 102, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as
- 16 amended by section 1 of Act 80, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is
- 17 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:



- 1 "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009;
- 2 provided that on July 1, [2024] 2030, this Act shall be
- 3 repealed and section 46-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be
- 4 reenacted in the form in which it read on the day before the
- 5 approval of this Act."
- 6 SECTION 3. Act 98, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, as amended
- 7 by section 4 of Act 102, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as amended
- 8 by section 50 of Act 55, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, as amended
- 9 by section 2 of Act 80, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
- 10 by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
- 12 and shall be repealed on July 1, [2024;] 2030; provided that
- 13 section 46-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted
- 14 pursuant to section 3 of Act 141, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009,
- 15 and section 23 of Act 96, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014."
- 16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
