A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342H-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 Felony disposal of solid waste is a class C felony 4 for which a [maximum] fine of no more than \$50,000 for each 5 separate offense may be imposed. In addition to the foregoing, 6 any vehicle owned and operated by the person in the commission 7 of the offense shall be subject to forfeiture pursuant to 8 chapter 712A." 9 SECTION 2. Section 342H-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 11 "(b) Petty misdemeanor disposal of solid waste is 12 punishable by: 13 (1)A fine of [not] no more than \$25,000 for each separate 14 offense; 15 (2)[Not] Imprisonment of no more than thirty days 16 [imprisonment] for each separate offense; or

1	(3)	Revocation	or	suspension	by	court	order	of	any

- 2 contractor's license or any applicable certificate of
- 3 authorization from the public utilities commission.
- 4 Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense. In
- 5 addition to the foregoing, any vehicle owned and operated by the
- 6 person in the commission of the offense shall be subject to
- 7 forfeiture pursuant to chapter 712A."
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
