STATEMENT OF OBJECTIONS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1586

Honorable Members
Thirty-Second Legislature
State of Hawai'i

Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I am returning herewith, without my approval, Senate Bill No. 1586, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources."

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds out of the University of Hawaii Tuition and Fees Special Fund for the College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources to establish two full-time extension specialist positions and three full-time extension agent positions.

This bill is objectionable because it erroneously classifies these new positions as "administrative, professional, and technical" positions. Pursuant to section 304A-1002, Hawaii Revised Statutes, extension specialists and extension agents are a part of the faculty classification. Faculty are represented by the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (UHPA), in bargaining unit 7, whereas administrative, professional, and technical positions are represented by the Hawaii Government Employees Association in bargaining unit 8. This bill would compel the UHPA to file a petition for clarification or amendment with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board to correct the classification to faculty, consistent with all other extension specialists and extension agents.

For the foregoing reasons, I am returning Senate Bill No. 1586 without my approval.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the university of
2	Hawaii tuition and fees special fund the sum of \$500,000 or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
4	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5	year 2024-2025 for the college of tropical agriculture and human
6	resources at the university of Hawaii at Manoa to establish five
7	administrative, professional, and technical full-time equivalent
8	(5.0 APT FTE) positions; provided that the sums appropriated
9	shall be expended as follows:
10	(1) \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
11	technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension
12	specialist in entomology in Hilo, county of Hawaii;
13	(2) \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
14	technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension
15	agent in livestock in Hilo, county of Hawaii;
16	(3) \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
17	technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) state

1		extension specialist in livestock at the university of
2		Hawaii at Manoa;
3	(4)	\$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
4		technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension
5		agent in livestock in the county of Kauai; and
6	(5)	\$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
7		technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension
8		agent in farm and consumer food safety in the county
9		of Maui.
10	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
11	of Hawaii	for the purposes of this Act.
12	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
