Aloha Senate President Kouchi and Speaker Saiki:

The Hawai'i State Teachers Association (HSTA) and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 5 (Teachers). In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation, and the normal procedure is to transmit these cost items following ratification of the agreement by union membership. However, completion and notice of ratification of the agreement is expected on April 26, 2023, which is two days before the final decking deadline for bills. In anticipation of ratification before the end of the legislative session, the following summary of the included and excluded requirements of the settlement for the current fiscal biennium is being transmitted to the Legislature to facilitate the appropriation authorization process:

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
