A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A STATE PERMITTING OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that delays in the county
- 2 building permit process have severely impacted the ability of
- 3 the State to commence state construction projects. The
- 4 legislature further finds that construction delays have
- 5 increased construction costs and harmed the livelihoods of state
- 6 contractors.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to establish a state permitting
- 8 office to quickly and efficiently process building and
- 9 infrastructure permits for construction of state buildings,
- 10 state roads and highways, and other construction on state lands,
- 11 while simultaneously ensuring that the construction complies
- 12 with all state and county building and infrastructure
- 13 requirements.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 16 to read as follows:

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2	§107-A Definitions. For purposes of this part:
3	"Department" means the department of accounting and general
4	services.
5	"Office" means the state permitting office established
6	pursuant to section 107-B.
7	"State permit" means a permit issued by the state
8	permitting office.
9	§107-B State permitting office; purpose. There is
10	established the state permitting office within the department.
11	Subject to the requirements of this part, the state permitting
12	office shall:
13	(1) Review applications containing state building and
14	infrastructure construction plans to ensure that the
15	plans satisfy the state building code as required by
16	section 107-31, the applicable county building code,
17	and any other applicable construction codes; and
18	(2) Issue a state permit to the applicant if the
19	application satisfies all applicable codes or deny the
20	application if the application does not satisfy all
21	applicable codes.

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- 1 §107-C State permit authorized. (a) A person may obtain
- 2 a state permit from the office in lieu of obtaining a county
- 3 building or infrastructure permit required by any county for any
- 4 type of work regarding a state building, state infrastructure,
- 5 or any type of work on state land.
- 6 (b) Notwithstanding any law or ordinance to the contrary,
- 7 any person who obtains a state permit under this part shall not
- 8 be liable for any failure to obtain a county building or
- 9 infrastructure permit for the same work submitted in an
- 10 application to the office for which the state permit was issued.
- 11 \$107-D Certificate of occupancy; infrastructure
- 12 connections. (a) The county in which the state project is
- 13 located shall issue a certificate of occupancy to the State for
- 14 any building for which a state permit was issued under this
- 15 part, upon:
- 16 (1) Completion of the building for which the state permit
- 17 was issued;
- 18 (2) The building passing final inspection by a state-
- designated inspector; and
- 20 (3) Formal acceptance of the building by the State.

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- 1 (b) Each county in which a state project is located shall
- 2 allow projects issued a state permit under this part to connect
- 3 with any and all required infrastructure services, including but
- 4 not limited to potable water, wastewater, stormwater, solid
- 5 waste, and other county-provided services.
- 6 §107-E Rules. The state permitting office, in
- 7 consultation with the state building code council, shall adopt
- 8 rules pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for this part, including
- 9 rules addressing the permit application process, required
- 10 submissions, and fees."
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 15 year 2024-2025 for the establishment of the state permitting
- 16 office.
- 17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 18 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. In codifying the new section added by section 2
- 20 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute

- appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 1
- the new sections in this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
