A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a civil lawsuit in
- 2 federal court alleged that a group of women at the women's
- 3 community correctional center were sexually assaulted at least
- 4 fifty-three times from 2013 to 2016. A similar case, Smith v.
- 5 State of Hawaii, resulted in a \$100,000 settlement, with \$50,000
- 6 coming from the State and another \$50,000 coming from the guard
- 7 who pled quilty. These lawsuits pointed specifically to the
- 8 lack of cameras in the correctional center's control rooms,
- 9 where a majority of the sexual assault allegedly occurred.
- 10 According to court documents, in some cases, staff offered food,
- 11 makeup, crystal meth, and special privileges to inmates in
- 12 return for compliance with sexual demands and punishments for
- 13 noncompliance. Any sexual contact between an inmate and staff
- 14 is a felony under existing law because prisoners cannot legally
- 15 give consent.
- 16 The legislature further finds that additional cameras in
- 17 control rooms and body cameras for all guards would help deter

- 1 sexual assaults and contraband, thereby building a defense
- 2 against future lawsuits and protecting inmates from roque
- 3 quards.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for:
- 5 (1) The purchase and installation of digital cameras in
- 6 all guard control rooms at state correctional
- facilities; and
- **8** (2) The purchase of body cameras for quards to wear while
- 9 on duty at state correctional facilities.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 14 year 2024-2025 to purchase and install digital cameras in all
- 15 quard control rooms at state correctional facilities and to
- 16 purchase body cameras for guards to wear while on duty at state
- 17 correctional facilities.
- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 19 of public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. On January 1, 2024, all responsibilities and
- 21 appropriations under this Act shall transfer from the department

- 1 of public safety to the department of corrections and
- 2 rehabilitation, as established by Act 278, Session Laws of
- **3** Hawaii 2022.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
