A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in 2022, fifty-one
- 2 school shootings occurred nationwide. These incidents include
- 3 situations where a firearm was discharged and an individual
- 4 other than a suspect or perpetrator was wounded by a bullet.
- 5 Nationally, school shooting incidences have also occurred on K-
- 6 12 school property, on a school bus, while school was in
- 7 session, and during a school-sponsored event. The second
- 8 deadliest K-12 shooting in United States history occurred in the
- 9 last year.
- 10 The legislature also finds that, while the department of
- 11 education requires annual fire drills, zero students have
- 12 perished in school fires since 1958. The legislature believes
- 13 that it is necessary to provide the appropriate training to
- 14 school staff and students that reflects the events currently
- 15 happening in the country.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 17 education to work with certain organizations to develop and

- 1 implement an active shooter training program in all public
- 2 schools under the jurisdiction of the department.
- 3 SECTION 2. The department of education shall work with the
- 4 Hawaii State Teachers Association, Hawaii Government Employees
- 5 Association, and Hawaii United Public Workers to develop and
- 6 implement an active shooter training program in all public
- 7 schools under the jurisdiction of the department.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
