

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIP CREDIT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: 7 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 10 \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; (4)\$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 11 (5) 12 \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; (6) 13 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018; (7) 14 \$12.00 per hour beginning October 1, 2022; (8) 15 (9) \$14.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; **16** \$16.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026; and (10)17 \$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2028. 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    2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the
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    employee's employer and in tips is at least $7.00 more than the
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    applicable minimum wage.
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              Beginning January 1, 2024, and each year thereafter,
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    the department shall calculate an adjusted tip credit amount to
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    be effective on the following January 1. The adjusted tip
    credit amount shall be calculated by adjusting the effective tip
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- 1 credit amount to be equal to twenty per cent of the effective
- 2 minimum wage as determined pursuant to subsection (a)."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
