A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COURT INTERPRETERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that court interpreters			
2	are independent contractors of the judiciary, who play an			
3	integral role in the administration of justice in the State,			
4	which has one of the highest proportions of non-English speake			
5	in the nation. The legislature further finds that court			
6	6 interpreters are often required to drive to distant courthous			
7	sometimes for hours, to provide interpretation services that are			
8	critical for a defendant with limited English proficiency in			
9	exercising their constitutional and statutory right to represen			
10	themselves in court or assist counsels in doing so.			
11	The legislature finds however, that despite the substantial			
12	increase in the cost of living in Hawaii over the years,			
13	including the considerable increase in the price of automobiles			
14	and gasoline, the compensation for court interpreters has			
15	remained unchanged for the most part since it was established in			
16	2007. The legislature therefore finds that an increase in the			
17	fees and rates for court interpreters is overdue.			

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         Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
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    judiciary to increase the hourly fees, mileage reimbursement
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    rate, and commuter-time compensation rate for court interpreters
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    to reflect the significant increase in the cost of living in

10	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

13	year 2024-2025 to fund the increase in the hourly rates, mileage			
14	reimbursement rate, and commuter-time compensation rate for			
15	court interpreters pursuant to this Act.			
16	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary			
17	for the purposes of this Act.
