A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEONICOTINOIDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that neonicotinoid
 insecticides are neurotoxic insecticides that permanently bind
 to insect nerve cells, overstimulating and destroying them.
 Neonicotinoids are the most widely class of insecticides
 worldwide.
- The legislature further finds that research overwhelmingly shows that neonicotinoid pesticides have destructive impacts on pollinator populations, killing bees, butterflies, and birds, and pose a serious threat to food systems, ecosystems, and public health. Growing scientific evidence also suggests that neonicotinoids have serious negative health impacts for humans.
