8		law,	which shall serve as temporary supplemental
9		sourc	es of funding for the State in times of an
10		emerg	ency, economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction
11		in re	venue, as provided by law; or
12	(3)	Appropriate general funds for the pre-payment of	
13		eithe	r or both of the following, as provided by law:
14		(A)	Debt service for general obligation bonds issued
15			by the State; or
16		(B)	Pension or other post-employment benefit
17			liabilities accrued for state employees."
